SEC Delburn Wind Farm delivers Victoria's first 100% publicly owned, utility-scale wind generation project just south of the Latrobe Valley in Gippsland.

Once operational in 2028, the 33-turbine wind farm will generate up to 205-megawatts of renewable energy, enough to power more than 130,000 homes.

SEC is working with OSMI Australia, Vestas, RES, and Delta Group to build and deliver the project.

SEC's anticipated capital expenditure of around \$650 million brings significant local economic benefits, including more than 300 local jobs.
